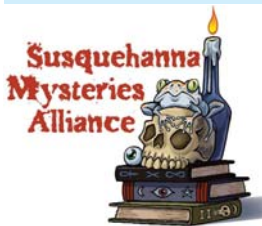
Join the Spirit Society of Pennsylvania

Recipes to die for

English Muffin Bread

From the secret recipe journal of Mr. Holmes, this bread is moist, dense, tastes just like an English Muffin and, to top it all off, it's easy to make!

- 3 Tablespoons Cornmeal (Divided)
- 6 Cups All Purpose Flour (Divided)
- 2 Envelopes Active Dry Yeast
- 1 Tablespoon Sugar
- 2 teaspoons Salt
- 1/4 teaspoon Baking Soda
- 2 Cups Milk
- 1/2 Cup Water

Lightly grease two loaf pans. Coat each with 1 Tablespoon of the cornmeal. Mix 3 cups of the flour, the yeast, sugar, salt and baking soda in a large bowl. Heat milk and water in a saucepan until warm. Stir into flour mixture. Stir in remaining flour. Spoon into prepared pans. Sprinkle tops with remaining cornmeal. Heat oven to 400 degrees. Bake 25 to 30 minutes until golden. Cool in pans or wire rack 5 minutes. Loosen edges with knife, remove from pan and cool completely. Store airtight. Serve warm or toasted.
