Join the Susquehanna Mysteries Alliance as we explore the darker areas of Pennsylvania's history and the haunted locations they've left behind today.

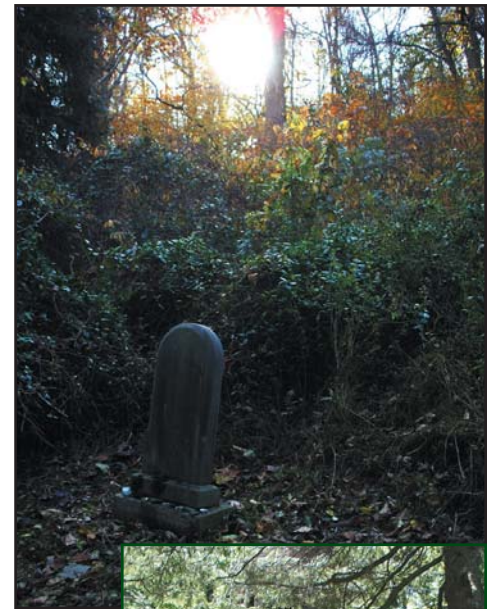
Most locations are open to the public and many are free to visit. Autumn is the perfect time of year to get outside and investigate these ghostly tales of other wordly phenomena.

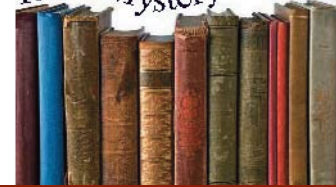


Over 30 people gathered and bundled up on Sept. 17 for SMA's Movie in the Meadow, *Arsenic and Old Lace*, and hot dog roast.

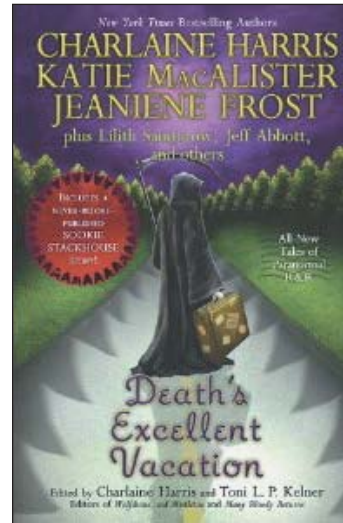
